

EARN LEED® INNOVATION CREDIT WITH INTERFACEFLOR

Have you heard the news? InterfaceFLOR styles backed with GlasBac®RE can earn an extra LEED credit through Innovation credits.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

STEP ONE - Choose InterfaceFLOR
Choose InterfaceFLOR styles backed with GlasBac RE for your LEED projects.

STEP TWO - Do the math
Compare the materials cost of your InterfaceFLOR modular carpet against the total cost of all building materials and products used in the project. If your InterfaceFLOR carpet reaches at least 1.25% of the total project material cost, you're ready for the Innovation point!

Not using enough InterfaceFLOR carpet to reach the 1.25% threshold? You can combine it with building products certified to the SMART standard — see details below.

STEP THREE - Get the documentation
Ask your local InterfaceFLOR Account Executive for the LEED documentation submittals. We'll send you the paperwork – electronically, of course.

We'll do the work; you get the point. How easy is that?

WANT TO KNOW MORE?

To encourage the availability and use of sustainable products, the USGBC has approved an innovation point for two types of product certifications: California Gold (for carpet) and SMART (for other building materials). These certifications offer a consistent, reliable measure of a product's sustainable achievement and this new ruling will reward projects for choosing products that meet these high standards.

To earn this point, California Gold or SMART certified products must account for 2.5% of the total value of all building materials and products used in a project, based on cost. Because InterfaceFLOR products backed with GlasBac RE are certified at the higher California Platinum level, their dollar value is doubled. In other words, InterfaceFLOR styles with GlasBac RE need comprise only 1.25% of the total value of a project to meet the requirement. And GlasBac RE styles still contribute toward credits for Low Emitting Carpet, recycled content, and other credits.

IT'S ALL ABOUT OUR MISSION ZERO PROMISE

These standards are point-based, which means California Gold is great, and California Platinum is even better. Products are evaluated based on the manufacturing process and the use of renewable energy and energy efficiency; recycled and biobased organic materials; increased water conservation; facility and company achievements; social equity; and product reuse and reclamation.
